## **BLEACH TABLETS – 02031**

Chlorine disinfectant tablet recommended by the Department of Health and the Health Protection agency as a comprehensive and recognised infection control regime.

- Long shelf life up to 5 years
- Easily measured dose
- Cost effective and safer alternative to liquid bleach

#### **USES:**

For use in professional catering areas and kitchens, washrooms, bedrooms, reception areas, sluice rooms etc.

Removes bad smells such as urine and rancid food at the source and not mask them as kills the bacteria that produce the smell.

Highly recommended for disinfecting spillages of blood and body fluids and for disinfecting cloths and mop heads.

Produces over three times the antibacterial killing power of normal bleach.

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Wear suitable gloves. Dissolve tablet in appropriate amount of water, as directed. Ensure tablet is completely dissolved before use.

Body fluid spills – 1 tablet in 100ml min contact time 2 minutes.

General disinfection – 1 tablet in 1ltr min contact time 15 minutes.

Stainless steel instruments – 3 tablets in 5ltrs and immerse for 1 hour.

WCs, drains, sinks – 1 tablet in 2.5ltr. Pour in solution during quiet periods.

Food prep surfaces, floors, tiles -1 tablet in 5ltrs and allow to soak for 3 minutes and air dry or use disposable paper towels.

Dishcloths, mops etc – 1 tablet in 16ltrs do not soak overnight.

When stored upright in original sealed container shelf life is 12 months. Ensure tops are secure and do not leak. Use care when transporting.

#### Keep out of the reach of children.
